Sand Blasters Sample Student Work

As the second drawing within the unit, this sample is fairly sophisticated. The student includes all the important features of a quality drawing and some descriptive observations. Some students were able to successfully apply what they learned about quality drawings from Lesson 1. Other students produced semi-disorganized and incomplete drawings. The teacher's role is to help students make more accurate and complete drawings. Sharing samples, such as the one below, will help students understand what constitutes a complete and quality drawing.

The student's drawing contains the following important parts/features:

- 1. title
- 2. labels for each card
- 3. some details (sand and glue)
- 4. appropriate sizing so that all the parts/details can be viewed
- 5. organization

Areas for improvement:

- 1. Use a ruler to draw straight lines.
- 2. Include more details in written observations, such as the size of the sand grains on each card.
- 3. Make grains of sand on drawing clearer.
- 4. Include the date the drawing was made.
